Maths

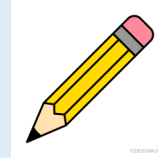
This half term we will continue to explore Complete Maths to cover time, statistics, shape and direction.

Please encourage your child to use both Tackling Tables and our new program Complete Maths at home to reinforce what we are learning at school and to share their learning with you.

English

This term we will be using Oliver Twist as a class reader to support all of our English, Reading and Grammar work.

We will be writing a biography of Charles Dickens, a setting description, a recount and a short narrative.



Reading

We will continue to enjoy and learn through our Whole Class Reading sessions.

Please read as often as possible with your child—they love to put a ticket in the monster and a stamp towards their 'One Hundred Reads each time that they have read—don't forget to write in their reading journal.

SPAG

Spellings will continue to be sent home and tested on a Thursday so please ensure your child has their book in school for their next spellings every Thursday. We will work on the statutory spelling lists this half term.

Science

Our topic this term is Forces and Magnets. We will be learning about and exploring invisible forces, such as, gravity, friction and magnetism. We will investigate how friction works and learn that the Earth has a magnetic force within it.

RE

Our key question this term is...
How does a Muslim show their submission and obedience to Allah?
We will be exploring how obedience is a key principle in the Islamic faith.

PE

Seacole Class will have PE on a Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon, however with lots of exciting events coming up this term, please ensure your child has their PE kit in school every day.

History

This term we will learn about the Wars of the Roses.

Exploring how the Houses of York and Lancaster fought to gain control of the county.



Geography

Our learning this term will focus on China, India and Asia.

The children will learn about these Asian countries, their features, landmarks and their influence in the world. We will conclude the unit with a comparison of these two countries.

RSHE

This term we will complete our Safety unit and learn about Managing Change.

In this unit we are working to explore changes which are expected and unexpected and how we can be resilient to these changes as we go through life.

Computing

This term we are learning about Simulations and Graphing.

The children will learn what Simulations are, evaluate them, creating and analysing their own.

In Graphing the children will use 2Graph to create their own graphs.

Art/DT

In Art we will continue to learn about Architecture, this term moving onto Modern Architecture.

In DT we will complete the planning and build our shell structures using Purple Mash to support our CAD skills.

French

Our unit this term is bon anniversaire. The children will learn to talk about different snack foods.

The children will begin to write simple French words.
